Waveair keeps the atmosphere fresh by eliminating foul vent smells

Many boat owners will recognise the particularly offensive odour from tank vents especially from the black water tanks when flushing toilets. For some people, the combination of unpleasant odour with a boat's motion can exacerbate sea sickness*.

There's a solution thanks to Wave International's Waveair, which is designed to filter out bad odours expelled by holding tank vents.

Waveair is a compact tube-shaped filter, available in two sizes. The Waveair Micro is just 200 mm long, and the Waveair standard measures 430 mm. Both models come complete with brackets and hose connections designed to fit to 16 mm, 19 mm or 25 mm connectors.



The Waveair filter is installed into the vent line after the holding tank and before the outlet. The sophisticated filter media inside the Waveair removes the organic compounds which create the foul smell. Once installed, the Waveair will operate effectively for at least 12 months before requiring a filter change. New replacement filter cartridges are available through Wave's network of international distributors and dealers.

The Waveair costs from around £35.00 ex VAT and can be easily retrofitted into any design of sail or motorboat.
